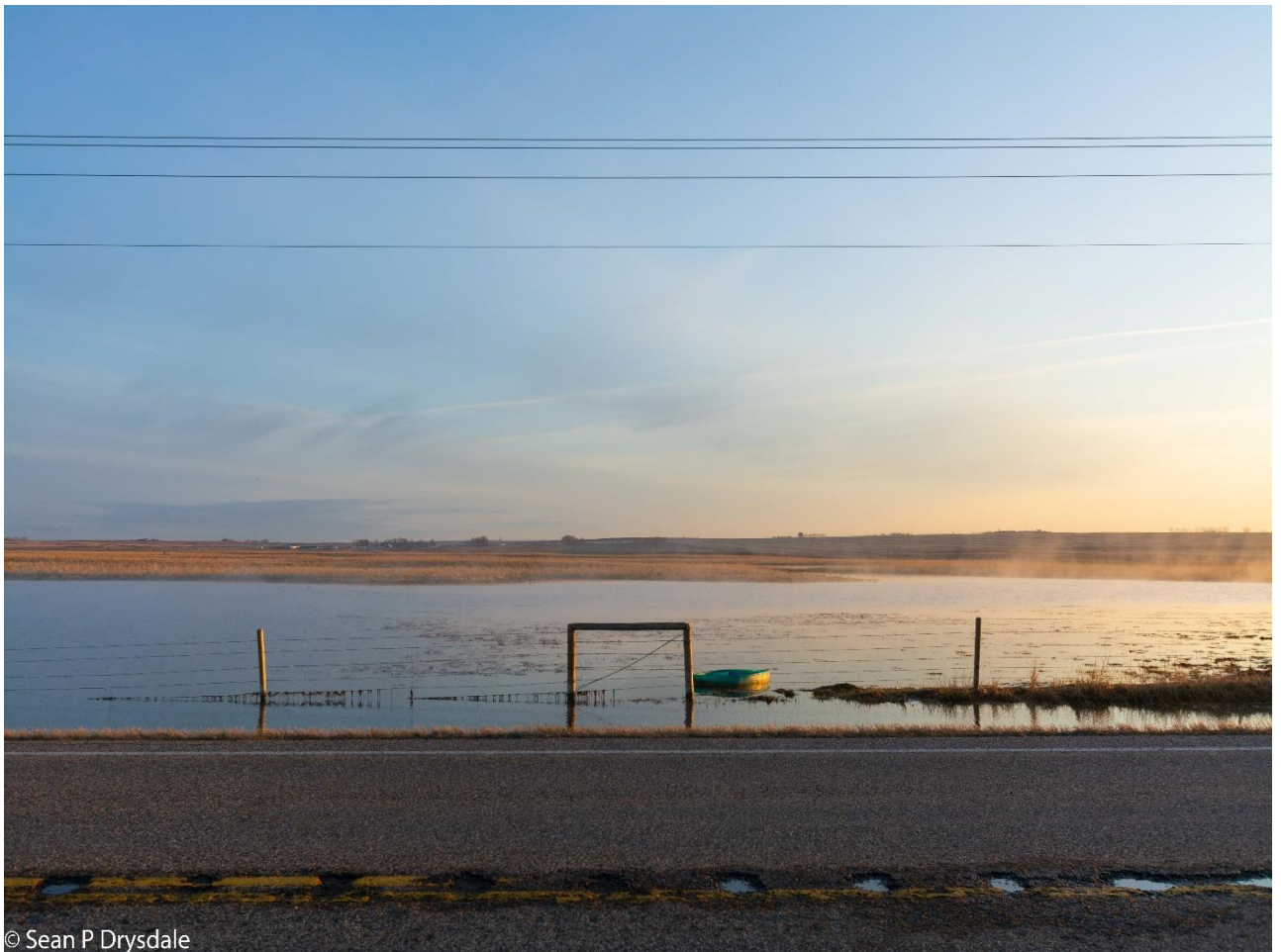


TOO LATE BUT ...
